Dear Alumni,

Literature textbooks do not quickly lose their value and worth, but the types of literature we can offer students vastly varies from year to year. We are asking for support to:

- ☑ update classroom literature,
- ☑ provide accessibility to our students,
- ☑ adopt new literature in order to mix in with the classics we currently teach and
 - \square to offer variety and choices to our students.

We are also striving to comply with the ever-changing standards and incorporate more informational text into the curriculum, and this is widely missing.

Currently, we are proposing that \$1,000 be spent on each grade 7-12, to update the curriculum. This need stems from the changing expectations of standards, but is also compounded by the fact that while Litchfield Elementary School received the SIG III Grant, the middle and high school did not. We now have students who will be moving from the elementary to the middle school; in order to continue to provide them with the necessary materials for success, we need help in procuring these items.

The chart below shows what types of materials to be purchased, for which grades, and expected cost of these materials. We also have a unique opportunity when purchasing from Partner's East Book Distributing to receive a 40% discount based on the amount of money we will be spending with them. *Essentially, this means stretching the* \$6,000 budget to \$8,400, to be spread over each grade respectively.
