ANNUAL FUNDRAISING GOAL FOR 2025 IS \$10,000 FOR HP NOTEBOOKS & CHARGING CART FOR JUNIORS AND SENIORS

The Alumni Association has raised over \$170,000 for the Litchfield Community Schools over the past 19 years. The teachers and staff are very appreciative of our contributions toward improving the educational experience for them and the students.

We received the following request from Cristina Eyre, Superintendent:

"Our students work on devices that only have access to Google Chrome and its products. We have recognized that most businesses and post-secondary institutions do not use Google. We would like to have devices available for our upperclassmen to learn how to use Microsoft Word, Excel, and PowerPoint. This enables us to prepare our students/graduates to be more marketable for jobs and more prepared for post-secondary educational and training programs."

The Alumni supported replacements for Chrome Books in 2023 and those will continue to be used in grades 3 to 10. Purchasing new HP laptops for Juniors and Seniors will free up more Chrome Books for the lower grades. The school has seen increased enrollment this year, the only one in the county, so this will help ensure that all students have access to Chrome Books.

The cost of the 20 HP ProBook 450 GIO 15.6" is \$12,075.

The school is seeking support from the Guise Foundation, and they have some funding available, if needed, through their technology sinking fund.

During our March meeting the Alumni Board approved a fundraising campaign to purchase new HP notebooks and charging cart for the Junior and Senior classes. We would like to raise at least \$10,000 this year in support of this project.
